## **EPMP SERIES – TOP ACCESS**

## SAVE THESE INSTRUCTIONS

- Prepare ceiling with a rectangular cutout with 90 degree corners making sure that both top and bottom panels are cut on the same plane. Cutout size is 17.50" x 20.50" for EPMP-1722 or 24.00" x 24.00" for EPMP-2424.
- 4. Insert collar/trim assembly through cutout from the room side.




- 2. Remove luminaire base (trim and collar/trim assembly) from packing materials. (Please leave the Electrical assembly packed until step 8).
- 3. Remove four (4) screws that secure top base to collar. Set top base aside.






5. Support Collar/Trim assembly in place.

Align Top Base to Collar/Trim assembly and install the ten pieces of #10-x sheet metal screws. Tighten to 14 inch pounds (hand-tight).



- 7. Verify that the gasket is sealing the room-side surface and that there is compression of that gasket. If not, verify ceiling thickness (allowable ceiling thickness  $4.00" \pm 0.125"$ ).
- 8. Remove Electrical assembly from packing materials and set on a stable surface with LEDs facing up (adjacent to fixture from above ceiling).



- 9. Read marking labels and all package markings for important information including input voltage requirements.
- 10. Carefully remove wire-way cover.



 Make all electrical connections from a sealed conduit fitting or bushing to prevent condensation from entering the luminaire.



12. Verify grounding connections to green terminal/ wire provided.



13. Secure wireway cover so that all wires are contained within the compartment.



14. LEDs are sensitive and must be protected. Do not place the electrical assembly face down on any surface other than the Top-Base, as intended.

15. Align Electrical assembly with Top Base and connect green bonding jumper.



16. Secure Electrical assembly to Top Base with (4) captive screw provided.



- 17. Secure steel aircraft support cable(s) to Top Base and structure, removing slack in cables.
- 18. Energize from a protected branch circuit not exceeding the marked input voltage ratings.
